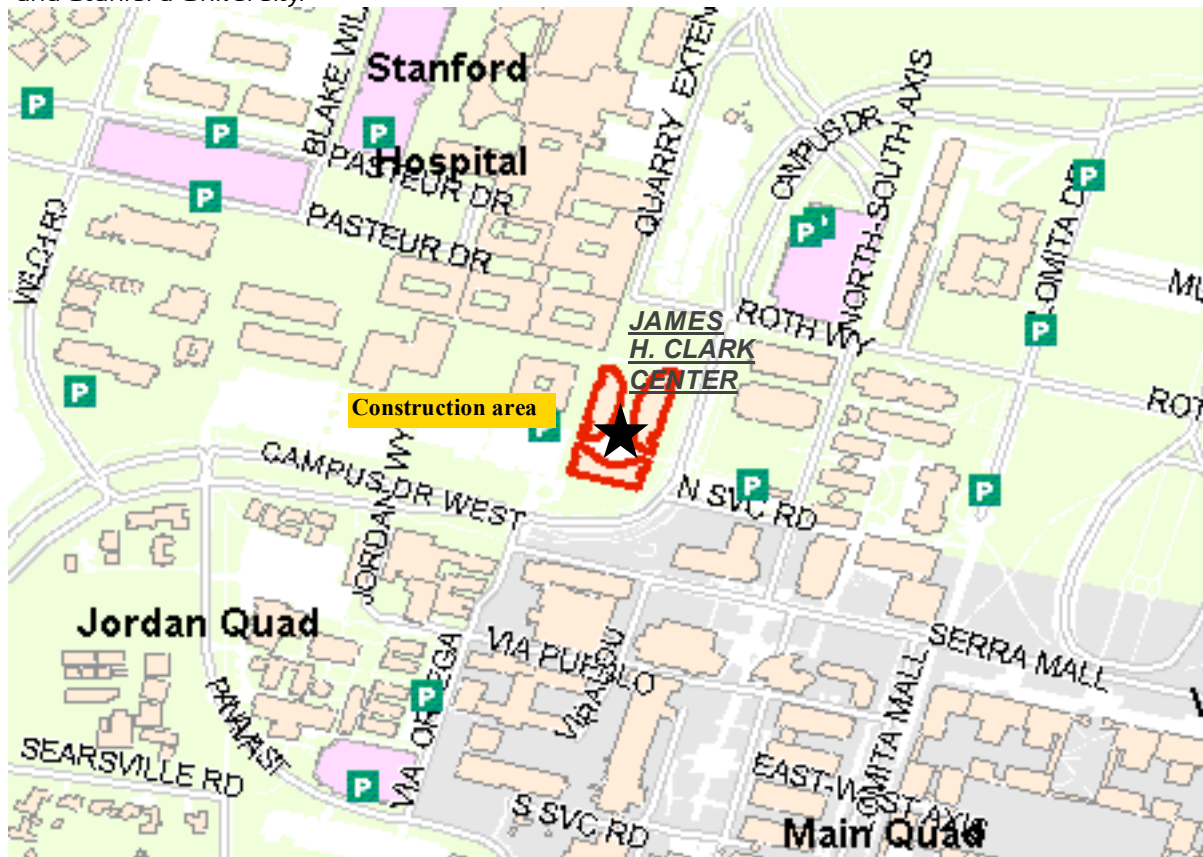

**From 280**

Take Sand Hill or Alpine to Sand Hill; turn **RIGHT** onto Stockfarm; Go to end of Stockfarm; Turn **LEFT** onto Campus Drive; James H. Clark Center will be on your **LEFT** at the curve.

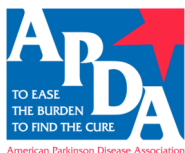
**-OR-**
